Salt Water Pipeline Leak in Stark County

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) has been notified of a brine (salt water) spill resulting from a pipeline leak in Stark County at a site operated by C12 Energy North Dakota LLC. The spill occurred on Monday, Jan. 4, approximately one-half mile north of Dickinson.

Initial estimates indicate approximately 140 barrels of brine and 10 barrels of oil were released. At this time it appears that no surface water has been impacted. Personnel from the North Dakota Oil and Gas Division and the NDDoH are at the site and will continue to monitor the cleanup.
