

EMERGENCY VEHICLE OPERATOR INSTRUCTOR COURSE

An Emergency Vehicle Operations Instructor Course has been scheduled for June 17, 18 and 19, 2016.

The Emergency Vehicle Operator's Course equips ambulance operators with an array of defensive driving techniques and good driving habits that will help them to recognize and anticipate hazards. Operators are also informed of current North Dakota laws concerning emergency vehicle operations. Below is listed all pertinent information for the EVO Instructor course and attached is a registration form. Please read carefully all the information and submit your registration and payment.

- Course will be held Friday night, Saturday & Sunday, June 17, 18 & 19, 2016 at the Baymont Inn and Suites (former Seven Seas) in Mandan, ND.
- A minimum of 15 students is needed to hold the course.
- Course includes classroom instruction, low speed emergency driving techniques done in the ambulance on a driving pad, course administration procedures & implementation strategies.
- Cost includes all course materials (except cones). Instructor certificates and patches will be provided Jim Privratsky and the Division of Emergency Medical Systems.
- You must preregister for this course. **Please complete the registration form accompanying this notice and return by June 1, 2016.**
- You are required to bring a backup ambulance or suburban and proof of vehicle liability insurance.
- Fees are \$650.00 per student.
