### **Produced Water Spill in Bowman County**

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) has been notified of an oil and produced water spill resulting from a tank overflow in Bowman County at a site operated by Denbury Onshore, LLC. The spill occurred Wednesday, May 18, approximately 8 miles south of Marmarth.

Initial estimates indicate approximately 2,500 barrels of produced water and 400 barrels of oil were released. The report stated that a majority of the spill remained on the well pad. An undetermined portion of the release left the well pad and impacted pastureland located to the northwest of it.

Personnel from the North Dakota Oil and Gas Division and NDDoH are currently at the site and will continue to monitor the investigation.
