Re: TNCC/ENPC Reimbursement Program

The North Dakota Emergency Nurses Association (NDENA) is proud to continue the TNCC/ENPC reimbursement program in 2016 for RN's caring for trauma patients in North Dakota hospitals.

NDENA is committed to optimal trauma care in North Dakota hospitals and realizes that TNCC/ENPC are premiere national trauma nursing courses in which the standard of care for trauma patients is defined and taught. NDENA also recognizes the economic challenges our small North Dakota hospitals are facing, and we know that educational dollars are not plentiful!!

The reimbursement program is available to: (must meet all requirements)

- ❖ RNs who complete a 2 day TNCC/ENPC class, (1 day reverification class participants are not eligible) held in North Dakota.
- ❖ RNs who work in a North Dakota hospital
- ❖ The North Dakota hospital must be a designated Level III, IV, or V trauma center.
- ❖ The class must be completed between January 1, 2016, and December 31, 2016.

The procedure to receive the reimbursement is:

- ❖ The RN (or her/his hospital employer) registers and pays the fee for a TNCC/ENPC class.
- ❖ The RN attends and successfully completes the 2 day course. (1 day reverification class participants are not eligible.)
- ❖ The RN (or her/his hospital employer) submits:
 1. A TNCC/ENPC Reimbursement Form (see attached)
 2. A copy of the RN's verification card that the RN received upon successful completion of the course.

3. A copy of the RN's contact hour certificate that the RN received upon successful completion of the course.

Upon receipt of the above 3 confirmation data pieces, \$150.00 will be reimbursed to the RN (or her/his hospital employer) by NDENA. Reimbursement will be handled on a "first come, first served" (reimbursed) basis. (A limited amount of funds is budgeted for this program.)
