### **McKenzie County Vehicle Accident Results in Concrete Spill**

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Health (NDDoH) has been notified of a concrete release from a truck operated by Knife River Company. The spill occurred on Wednesday, Aug. 3, approximately 17 miles north of Watford City due to a vehicle accident.

Initial estimates indicate approximately one-third cubic yard of ready mix concrete, one quart of hydraulic fluid, and less than a pint of engine oil were released. Surface water in the form of a pond has been impacted.

Personnel from the NDDoH have been on site and will continue to monitor cleanup.
